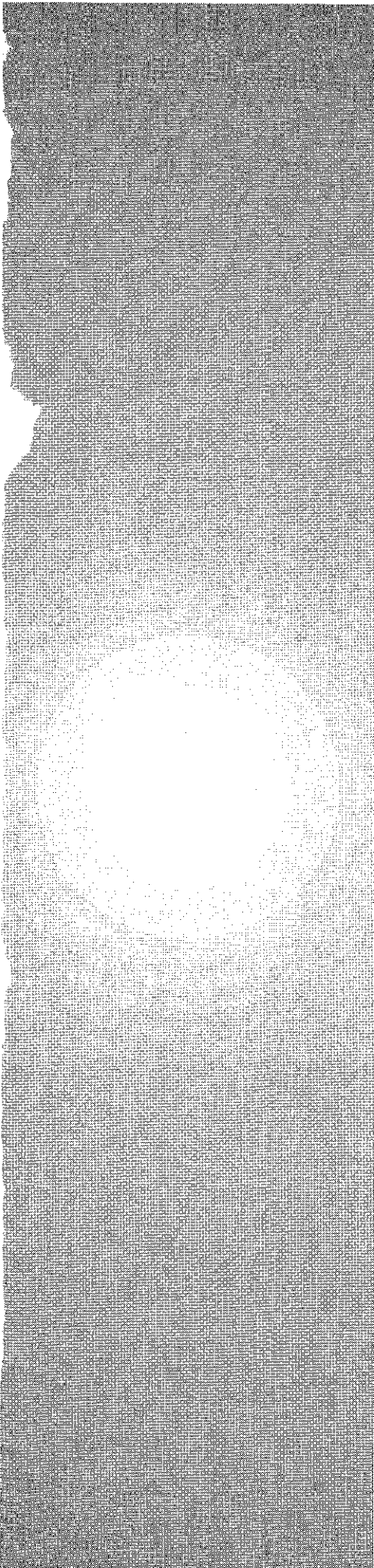

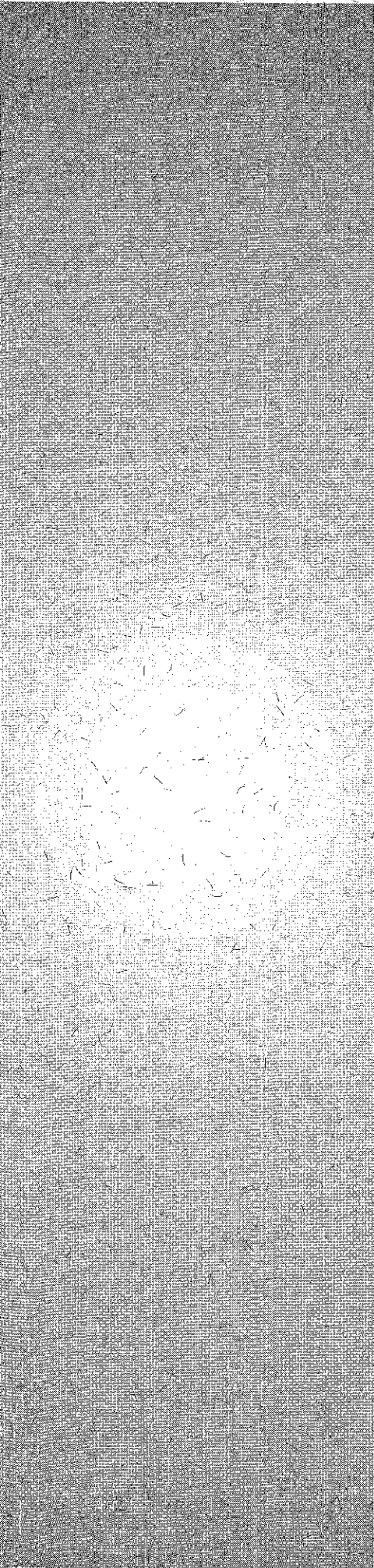

Section 1

Introduction

Introductory Statement

We are pleased to provide the 2000 Annual Report of Scholarly Productivity at Brigham Young University. The reporting of scholarly productivity at BYU began in 1989–1990. The report has evolved in the intervening years, though only minor changes in reporting categories from previous year's documents may be found herein. Every effort has been made to accurately compile data supplied by departments through the respective colleges.

During 2000, the 1,229 full-time university faculty produced, 2,700 scholarly works in categories 1–9 (see summary sections), representing 2.20 products per faculty member. Sixty-three percent of the faculty produced at least one such scholarly product during the year. By way of comparison, in 1999, the 1,244 faculty produced 2,202 scholarly products, representing 1.77 products per faculty member, and sixty-one percent of the faculty produced at least one scholarly work.

As you review this report, please note that on the chart reporting “Scholarly Productivity” found in each college section, “Publications & Artistic/Creative Activities” represents categories 4–9 in the Summary Section and “Books” represents categories 1–3.

Please note the list of recipients of the Undergraduate Research Scholarship and their faculty mentors. These \$1,000 scholarships are administered by the Office of Research and Creative Activities, and the applications and research proposals are evaluated at the university level by a faculty review panel. Additionally, this year we have added a listing of undergraduates who have graduated with University Honors as well as the faculty mentors involved.

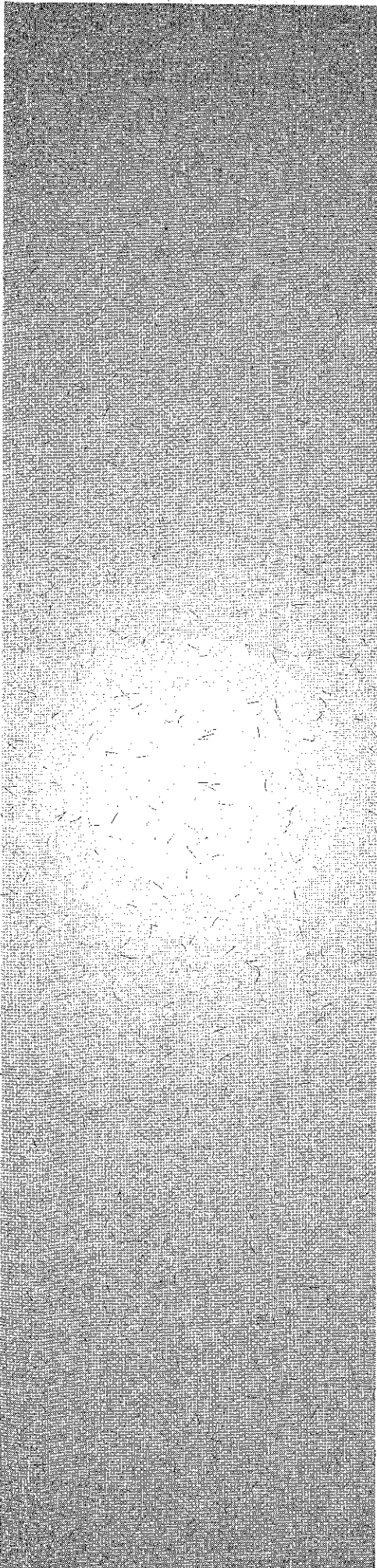

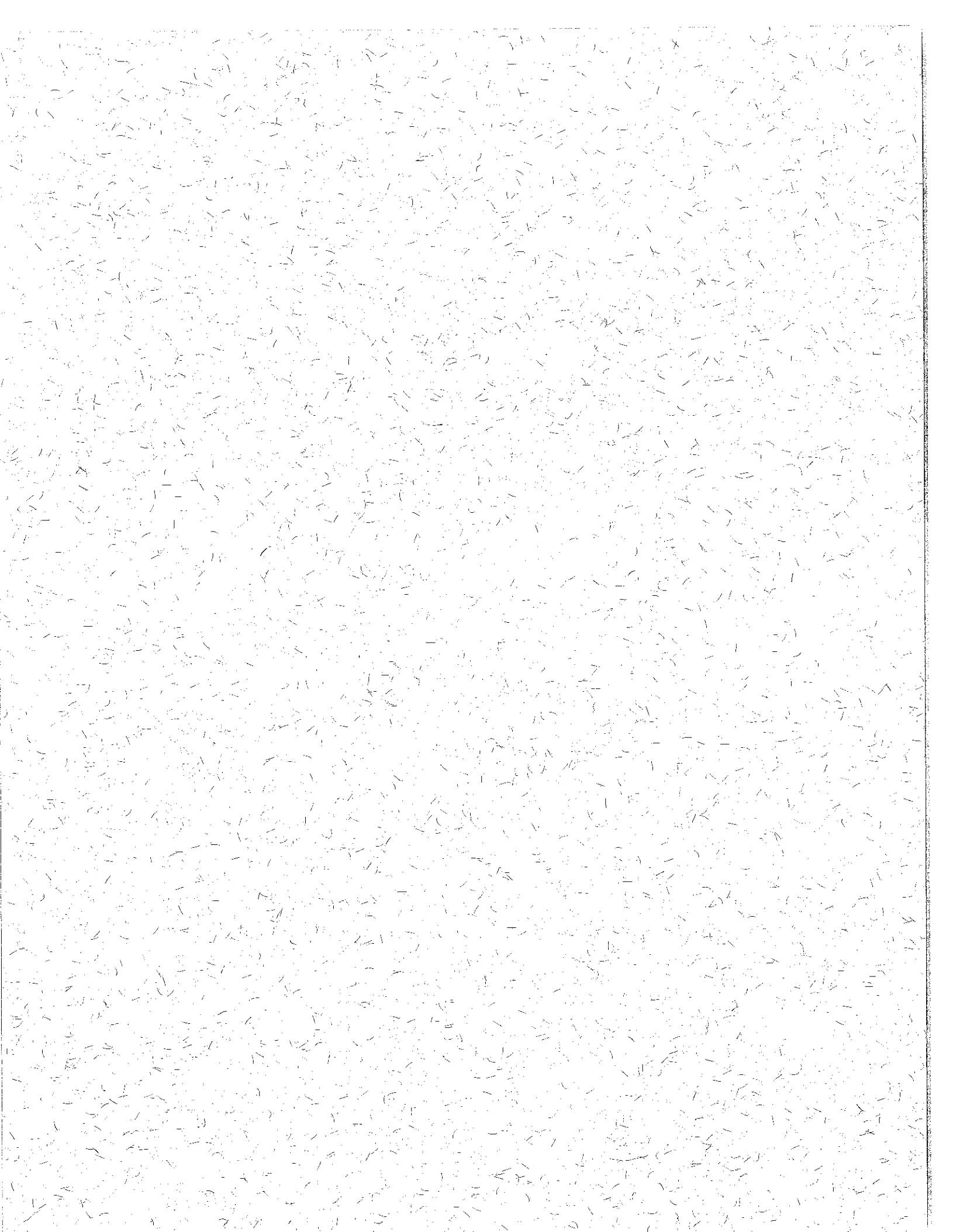

Section 2

Definitions & Explanations



College Report Format for the Annual Report of Scholarly Productivity

Guidelines/Philosophy

The Annual Report of Scholarly Productivity is the only unified listing of scholarly accomplishments for the university. As an indicator of scholarship at BYU, the report is intended to be used by departments and colleges as one measure of academic progress. In order to have significance as a reliable report, it is essential that all data be as complete and accurate as possible. It is the responsibility of the department, college and school administrators to make initial and critical judgements as to the appropriate reporting of academic performance indicators. The Office of Research and Creative Activities is then responsible to review the material and resolve any problems with the submissions. The following guidelines have been formatted and discussed by the Office of Research and Creative Activities, the Faculty Council on Research and Creative Activities of Brigham Young University, and the Associate Academic Vice President for Research and Graduate Studies.

The guidelines are exactly the same as last year, keeping the same underlying principles for each category. A primary presumption is that the submitted performance markers meet the expectations of scholarship of the departments and disciplines involved. The same standard of quality used in considering faculty for continuous status and salary adjustments is expected in the reporting process for the Annual Report. Those accomplishments that lead to enhanced reputation and recognition amongst academic peers are those to be included in this report.

For 2000 an effort was made to improve the submission process by transferring it to an electronic spreadsheet. The reviews were mixed. The idea of alternate methods of submitting the information has been pressed from several quarters for a number of years. However, the product used for this 2000 gathering had significant shortcomings. It is with a great deal of appreciation that we acknowledge the efforts of staff and faculty at both the Department and College levels for their work in assembling this information.

There are two main categories of performance indicators: a primary group which can be quantified and used in calculations such as departmental activity and productivity indices and a second category of significant indicators which are less easily quantified but are important academic accomplishments.

The Report: What Is Included?

Time Frame

All submitted titles must be within the calendar year 2000 (January 1–December 31). Only finished work is to be submitted. Work *in progress*, *in press*, *substantially completed* etc. **cannot** be listed.

Reporting Categories

I. List of Faculty

All professorial faculty in budgeted positions should be listed by name and rank. *Instructors, adjunct faculty, visiting faculty, part-time faculty, and those with stipulated positions should not be included.* In special cases, instructors with significant assignments in research and creative activities may be identified and listed. Faculty on leave may be so identified but will be included in the total number of faculty since their report will reflect past years' efforts. The number of faculty listed will be used in determining the activity and productivity indices.

II. Scholarly Writing

Scholarly writing is defined as written work in appropriate disciplines which has received *critical review*. Critical review most often will be *peer review*, but in some cases (books, some journals) the review is carried out by an editorial staff in ways other than typical peer review. While most scholarly writing will be in the appropriate discipline of the faculty, it is recognized that many BYU faculty outside of Religious Education may also have scholarly interests in religious topics. Some of these faculty may in fact have teaching assignments in religion and publish on religious topics. Such publications must meet appropriate standards of scholarship and review.

A. Scholarly Books

While all scholarly books will be considered in calculating the activity and productivity indices, they will be listed according to several subtitles.

1. Reference and Creative Books

Included in this category are those books directed towards a professional audience in the author's discipline. Scholarly religious books directed towards the professional audience

should also be included. Religious books may include those BYU published works which meet the appropriate level of scholarship and which are intended for scholarly reference rather than texts or the general public.

Creative books are original works of fiction, collections of prose and poetry, and other creative writing. This category does not include scholarly textbooks intended for student audiences. All books are to be authored or co-authored by the faculty, and the citation should include the author, publisher, pages, etc.

Example: Fleming, J. Clifton, Jr. and Janet A. Spragens. 1991. *Tax Aspects of Forming and Operating Closely Held Corporations*. Shepards/McGraw Hill, New York. 944 pp.

2. *Instructional Textbooks*

This category is limited to texts of high quality which have undergone rigorous editorial or peer review and are published by nationally or internationally recognized presses. They should be intended for broad audiences beyond BYU. *Books published by local, vanity, or other such publishing processes are not generally acceptable in this category.* Where special workbooks, software, etc. are co-published to accompany the texts, they should be listed. However, these will not be counted separately unless they have a “stand-alone” status on the market. Texts should be submitted according to the year of publication. Where subsequent rewrites and new editions are published, they should be submitted in the appropriate year of publishing.

Example: Moore, Hal G. and Adil Yaqub. 1992. *A First Course in Linear Algebra*, 2nd Ed. Harper Collins, New York. Feb 1992, 560 pp.

3. *Edited Scholarly Books*

This category includes anthologies, bibliographies, technical collections, and other works where scholarly writings are brought together with appropriate commentary and/or editing by the faculty member(s). The same standards and audience as identified in *A1* apply to this category.

B. Chapters in Books and Reviews

This category includes contributions to any subdivision of "Scholarly Book" where the criteria of audience and review have been met. Chapters in books must be clearly identified in the book index or table of contents as the separate work of the faculty member. Contributions to scholarly encyclopedias may be included in this category. The citation should identify the author/editors of the main work as well as the chapter in question. Forewords, introductions, dedications, and similar contributions to books are not considered "chapters" or "reviews."

Example: Arnold, Marilyn. 1991. Mixed Melody: Willa Cather's "Uncle Valentine." pp. 138–145, in Willa Cather: A Study of the Short Fiction. Ed., Loretta Wasserman. Twayne Publishers. New York.

C. Publications in Critically Reviewed Scholarly Journals and Proceedings

This category includes full length articles (no abstracts) and reports of original work published in recognized journals of the several disciplines. Published proceedings of meetings may also be included where the criteria of review and accessibility to the academic public are met. Peer-review is presumed in such journals or proceedings, but other appropriate critical review is acceptable if it is the practice of the journal and discipline. The presumption of "critical review" is that the work has been judged for quality and appropriateness by recognized representatives of the discipline.

Example: Rushforth, S.R. and J.R. Brock. 1991. Diatom Communities in the lower Truckee River, Nevada. *Hydrobiologia* 224:49–64.

D. Published Book Reviews

This category includes scholarly reviews of the works of others which are published in appropriate journals or societal proceedings. Such book reviews should be cited as per other scholarly publications (authors, title, journal, pages).

Example: Peterson, David C. Review of Exiles in a Land of Liberty: Mormons in America 1830–1846 by Kenneth H. Winn, and Religious Seekers at the Advent of Mormonism by Dan Vogel. In *Journal for the Scientific Study of Religion*. 30:127–130 (March 1991).

E. Significant Intellectual Properties

This category of scholarly indicators is intended to reflect the growing influence and acceptance of scholarship in a new tradition—tangible works other than books, publications, etc. Issued patents, registered copyrights for software, and complex academic and instructional materials which have been protected by a recognized process are examples of significant intellectual properties. Software that is distributed without protection or generally and freely distributed and typical educational materials (videos, tapes, workbooks) are not to be included.

Example: Caldwell, K.D., Chu, T.J., Pitt, W.G., DNA Sequencing using Fluorescence Background Electroblotting Membrane. U.S. Patent Number: 5, 112, 736 May 12, 1992. Patent Pending in Japan (1991) and Norway (1992).

III. Artistic and Other Creative Activities

Evidence of academic accomplishments in the performing and visual arts is varied. It may include typical books and publications, but they often extend to such creative expressions as actual performances, directing/producing of plays and performances, sculpture and paintings, compositions, and many other categories. Listed below are some typical categories. It is recognized that those submitting work for consideration must critically evaluate the submissions and apply their usual standards of academic worth and excellence to each item.

A. Juried, Invited and Commissioned Works

This category includes specific creations of faculty which have been judged and evaluated. This evaluation may occur via peer reviews of exhibited work. There may be instances also where prestigious and recognized organizations or entities specifically commission works or invited exhibits or performances. Some examples of work included in this category are paintings or sculptures which are in juried exhibits or prestigious single shows, musical scores performed in appropriate academic venues and original plays or films which are judged and otherwise evaluated. Where a work is exhibited or performed more than once in substantially the same form, one entry should be provided detailing all occasions involved.

Example: Kimball, W. Wayne, "Under South Western Skies." Juried, 1991 Biennial of Contemporary Art, Sangre de Cristo Arts and Conference Center, Pueblo, Colorado (1991).

B. Published Creative Works

This category includes such published work that does not fit in the category "Scholarly Writing." It specifically includes those works of design, book illustration, and other art which are accepted within the department(s) as evidence of faculty scholarship.

Citations of such work should specify the publication, page numbers, and other details similar to citations for other scholarly accomplishments. Whether the work was juried or commissioned should also be indicated.

Example: Barrett, Robert. "Dear Napoleon, I Know You're Dead But," Cover Illustration, published by Holiday House. 1992. Juried.

C. Performances, Productions or Interpretations of the Work of Others

This category includes major professional and public presentations of musical, dramatic, and dance works where critical review of the performance has occurred. The role of the faculty member in the performance should be clearly identified in the citation along with details of the venue, time, etc. This category specifically excludes performances at clubs, church meetings, and family or other personal gatherings unless clear evidence of relationship to academic evaluation can be demonstrated.

Example: Stuart-Bachelder, Lila. Performed "Mozart Requiem" with the Ohio Symphony and Choruses, Oberlin, Ohio. Oct. 1991.

IV. Scholarly Presentations

The participation of faculty in various academic situations, workshops, symposia, seminars, regional and national meetings, performances, etc., where the results are not critically reviewed or published as journal articles is a significant scholarly activity. This category is intended for a listing of such presentations by title, date, and location. *It is intended to include only the academically oriented and scholarly presentations and specifically excludes local presentations, unless they are significant to audiences beyond BYU or are major academic presentations.* Examples of the latter would be the Sigma Xi Lecture, the Distinguished Faculty Lecture, Forum Speeches, etc.

- V. *Editorships*
- This category recognizes the accomplishment associated with appointment or elections to editorial positions, including editorial boards of recognized scholarly publications. This recognition is limited to duly listed (on journal introductory sheets or covers) Editors, Associate/Assistant Editors and editorial board members. *Referees of manuscripts and ad hoc editorships are not to be included.*
- VI. *Other Evidence of Scholarly Accomplishment and Recognition*
- This category is intended as a place for accomplishments or other evidence of faculty recognition that do not fit other categories but are election to significant societal positions, Fulbright or other awards, funding that indicates confidence of peers but does not fit sponsored program reporting guidelines, etc.
- VII. *Research and Creative Activities Funding*
- The Annual Report will continue to list research and other projects funded by *external* agencies. Those projects which come through the Office of Research and Creative Activities need not be listed. They will be collected from our files. Please list, however, other research or creative projects funded from external sources—e.g., from gifts, endowments, and all sources *other than* re-distributed university funds.
- VIII. *Graduate Student Theses and Dissertations*
- Beginning in 1992–93, the Annual Report listed graduate degrees awarded as an evidence of faculty and institutional academic accomplishment. In this category, you should list all graduate degree *recipients* and the type of degree earned. Where the program is thesis or dissertation, the major professor should be identified. In other programs (non-thesis and professional), list the students and those assigned to administer the particular program. List only those who actually received a degree.

Activity and Productivity Indices

The activity index and the productivity index are generally used to compare departmental progress over time. The categories of accomplishments used to calculate them are thus as constant as possible. The Office of Research and Creative Activities will make the calculations from the primary data submitted by colleges.

Activity Index This index is a numerical value designed to show the extent to which a departmental or other faculty group participates in specified scholarly work. It is calculated as a fraction of faculty who have submitted at least one work in categories II and III (all sections). Categories IV–VIII are not considered in this calculation.

Productivity Index This index is a numerical value reflecting the average number of specified scholarly accomplishments per departmental or group faculty member. It is calculated by dividing the sum of entries in categories II and III by the total number of faculty involved (category I).

Carnegie Classification

Introduction

The Carnegie Foundation for the Advancement of Teaching publishes a guide to help colleges and universities evaluate their profile fact-to-fact with other institutions. Since total federal support is between \$15.5 and \$40.0 million, BYU is classified as a “Research University II.” However, most of this support is in the form of undergraduate student aid, and BYU federal research funding was only \$12,980,903 in 2000. Thus, in terms of research funding, BYU compares more closely to the Carnegie Classification of “Doctoral University I.”

Carnegie Classifications

The 1994 Carnegie Classification includes all colleges and universities in the United States that are degree-granting and accredited by an agency recognized by the U.S. Secretary of Education.

Research Universities I

These institutions offer a full range of baccalaureate programs, are committed to graduate education through the doctorate, and give high priority to research. They award 50 or more doctoral degrees each year. In addition, they receive annually \$40 million or more in federal support.²

Research Universities II

These institutions offer a full range of baccalaureate programs, are committed to graduate education through the doctorate, and give high priority to research. They award 50 or more doctoral degrees¹ each year. In addition, they receive annually between \$15.5 million and \$40 million in federal support.²

Doctoral Universities I

These institutions offer a full range of baccalaureate programs and are committed to graduate education through the doctorate. They award at least 40 doctoral degrees¹ annually in five or more disciplines.³

Doctoral Universities II

These institutions offer a full range of baccalaureate programs and are committed to graduate education through the doctorate. They award annually at least ten doctoral degrees—in three or more disciplines³—or 20 or more doctoral degrees in one or more discipline.

Master's (Comprehensive) Universities and Colleges I

These institutions offer a full range of baccalaureate programs and are committed to graduate education through the master's degree. They award 40 or more master's degrees annually in three or more disciplines.³

Master's (Comprehensive) Universities and Colleges II

These institutions offer a full range of baccalaureate programs and are committed to graduate education through the master's degree. They award 20 or more master's degrees annually in one or more discipline.

Baccalaureate (Liberal Arts) Colleges I

These institutions are primarily undergraduate colleges with major emphasis on baccalaureate degree programs. They award 40 percent or more of their baccalaureate degrees in liberal arts fields and are restrictive in admissions.⁴

Baccalaureate (Liberal Arts) Colleges II

These institutions are primarily undergraduate colleges with major emphasis on baccalaureate degree programs. They award less than 40 percent of their baccalaureate degrees in liberal arts fields and are less restrictive in admissions.⁴

Associate of Arts Colleges

These institutions offer associate of arts certificate or degree programs and, with few exceptions, offer no baccalaureate degrees.⁵

Professional and Specialized Institutions

These institutions offer degrees ranging from the bachelor's to the doctorate. At least 50% of the degrees awarded by these institutions are in a specialized field. Specialized institutions include:

Theological seminaries, Bible colleges and other institutions offering degrees in religion

This category includes institutions at which the primary purpose is to offer religious instruction or train members of the clergy.

Medical schools and medical centers

These institutions award most of their professional degrees in medicine. In some instances, their programs include other health professional schools, such as dentistry, pharmacy, and nursing.

Other separate health profession schools

Institutions in this category award most of their degrees in such fields as chiropractic, nursing, pharmacy, or podiatry.

Schools of engineering and technology

The institutions in this category award at least a bachelor's degree in programs limited almost exclusively to technical fields of study.

Schools of business and management

The schools in this category award most of their bachelor's or graduate degrees in business or business-related programs.

Schools of art, music and design

Institutions in this category award most of their bachelor's or graduate degrees in art, music, design, architecture or some combination of such fields.

Schools of law

The schools included in this category award most of their degrees in law. The list includes only institutions that are listed as separate campuses in the 1994 Higher Education Directory.

Teachers colleges

Institutions in this category award most of their bachelor's or graduate degrees in education or education-related fields.

Other specialized institutions

Institutions in this category include graduate centers, maritime academies, military institutes and institutions that do not fit any other classification category.

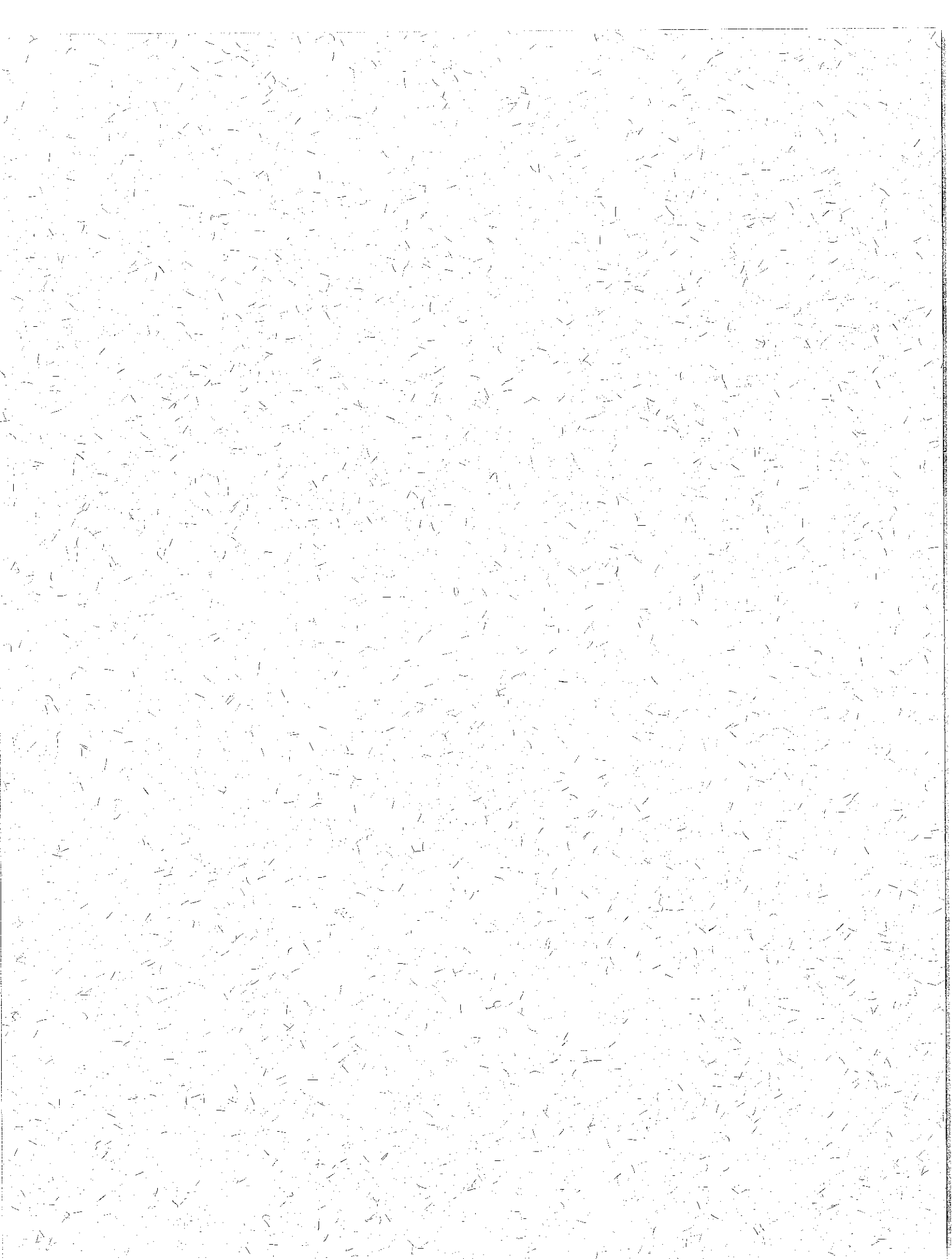
Tribal colleges

These colleges are with few exceptions, tribally controlled and located on reservations. They are all members of the American Indian Higher Education Consortium.

1. Doctoral degrees include Doctor of Education, Doctor of Juridical Science, Doctor of Public Health and the Ph.D. in any field.
 2. Total federal obligation figures are available from the National Science Foundation's annual report called Federal Support to Universities, Colleges and Nonprofit Institutions. The years used in averaging total federal obligations are 1989, 1990 and 1991.
 3. Distinct disciplines are determined by the U.S. Department of Education's Classifications of Instructional Programs four-digit series.
 4. The liberal arts disciplines include English language and literature, foreign languages, letters, liberal and general studies, life sciences, mathematics, philosophy and religion, physical sciences, psychology, social sciences and the visual and performing arts. The occupational and technical disciplines include agriculture, allied health, architecture, business and management, communications, conservation and natural resources, education, engineering, health sciences, home economics, law and legal studies, marketing and distribution, military sciences, protective services, public administration and services, theology, area and ethnic studies, and multi and interdisciplinary studies.
 5. This group includes community, junior and technical colleges.

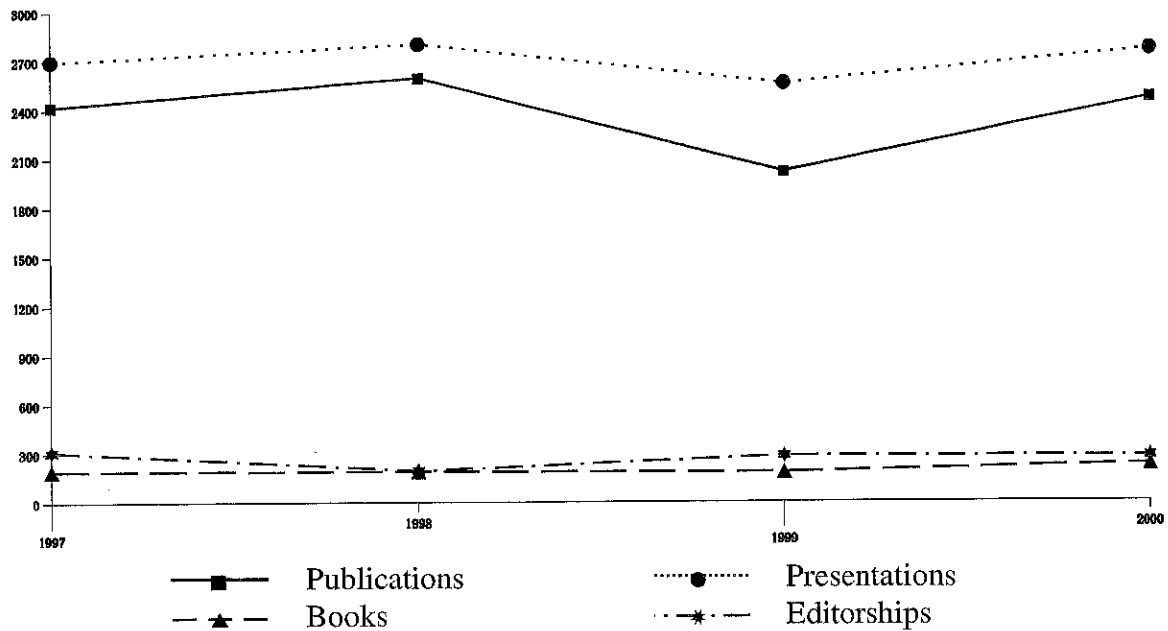

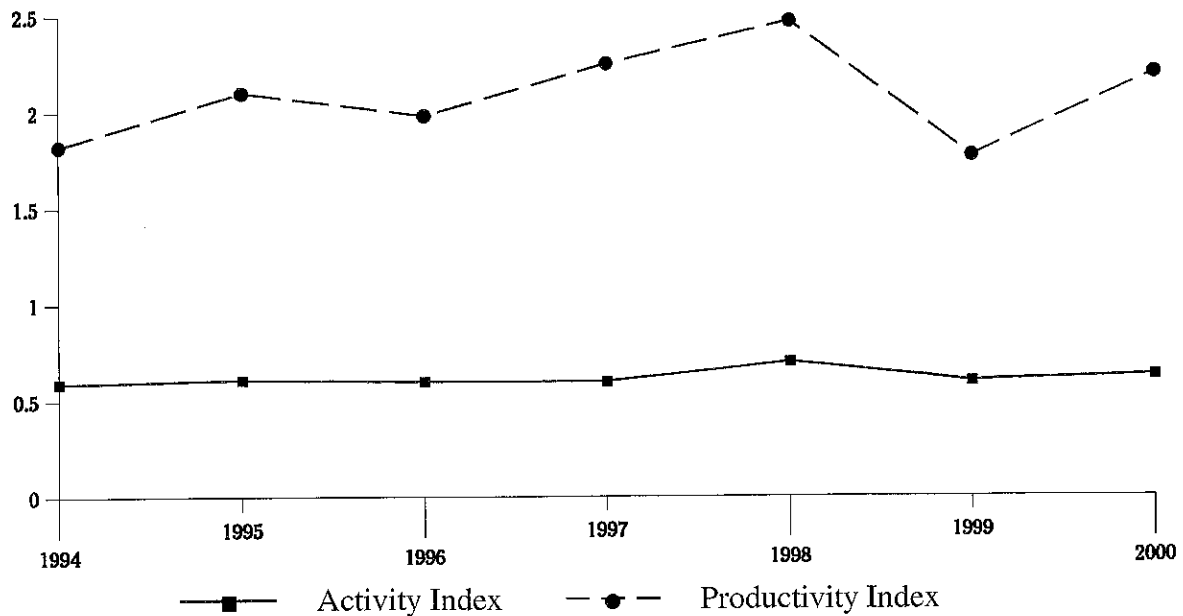

2000 Undergraduate Scholarship Recipients

This group is selected by a process resembling the faculty pursuit of external research funding. Students prepare proposals and select faculty mentors. A group of faculty and administrators carefully evaluate all proposals and select those deemed outstanding. The awards, \$1,000 scholarships, are given in January and a report on the work is due in August of the same year. These reports are tabulated as *The Brigham Young University Journal of Undergraduate Research and Creative Activities*, which is published on the World Wide Web under the ORCA home page (<http://www.byu.edu/tmcbucs/tt/orca.htm>).

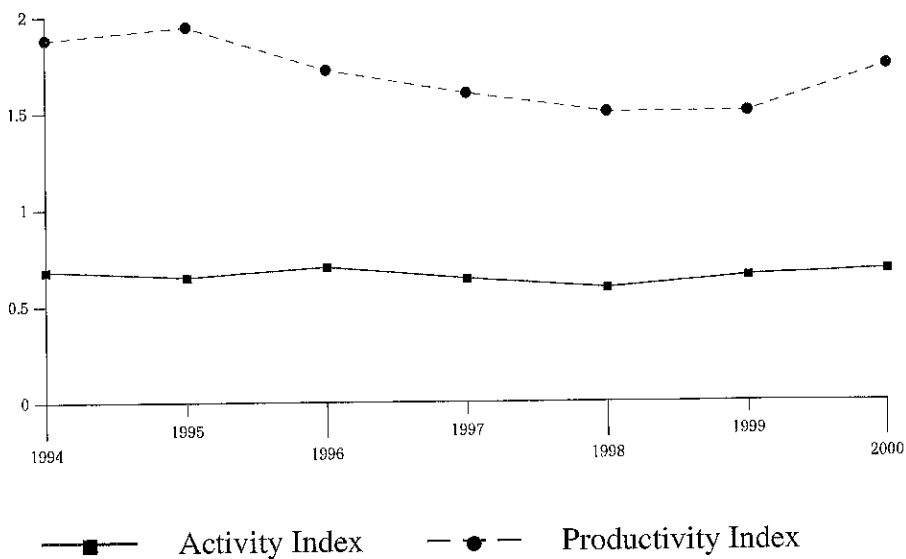

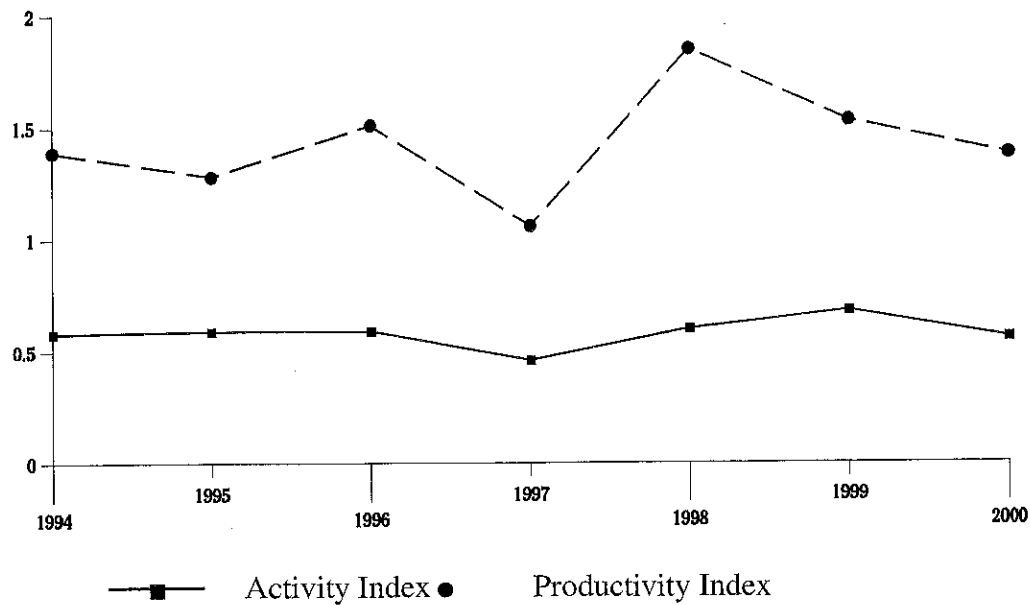

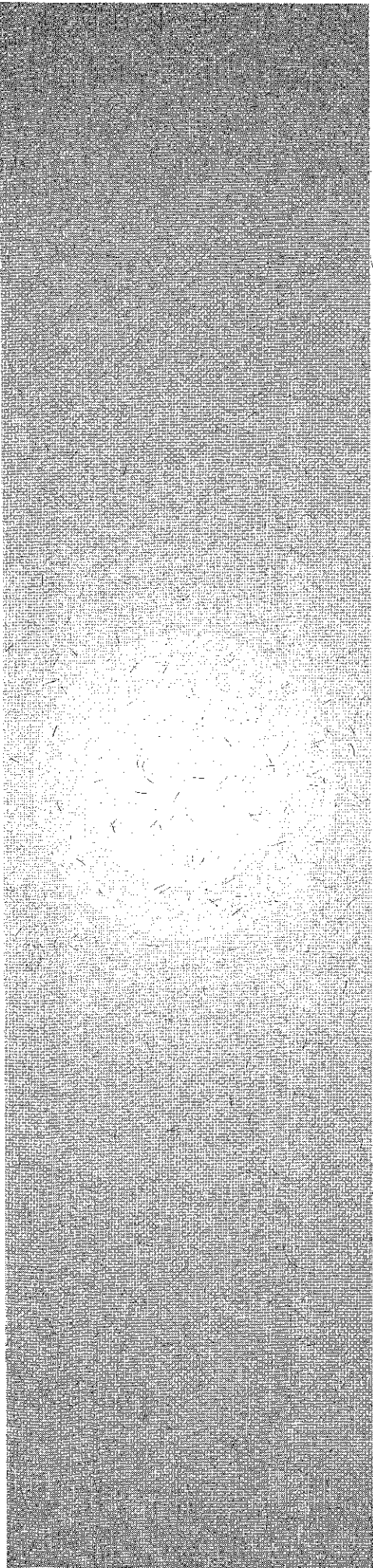

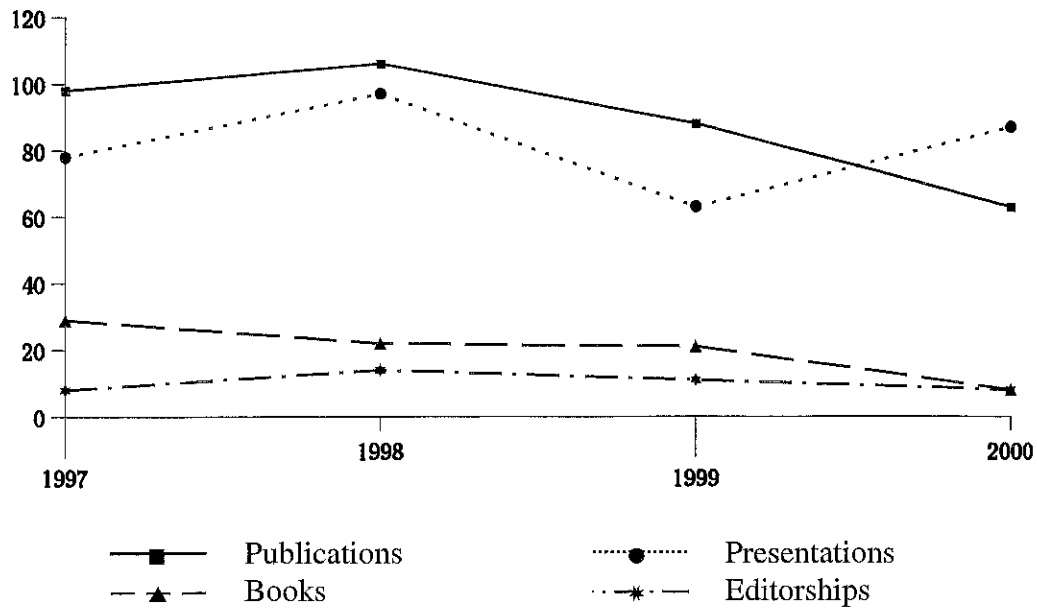
